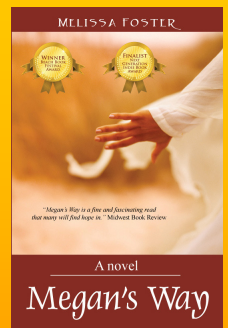
MELISSA FOSTER
